


We will increase the accidental insurance coverage for farmers to ₹3 lakh under Khedut Akasmat Bima Yojana.

We will ensure time-bound assessment of crop losses and disbursal of relief amount to farmers under the Mukhyamantri Kisan Sahay Yojana.

We will launch a Mukhyamantri Khedut Fellowship in which leading farmers from across the state will visit foreign countries to study best agricultural practices.

We will create 1,000 new FPOs in the next five years and provide interest-free loans up to ₹25 lakh through a corpus of ₹250 crore. We aim to make Gujarat's farmers self-reliant in their power requirements by doubling the number of solar water pump connections under the PM Kusum and Surya Shakti Kisan Yojana schemes.





Becoming a Leader in Agri-Exports

We will double Gujarat's agricultural export in the next 5 years.

We will launch the Gujarat Agro Exports Policy to boost agricultural exports, under which we will:

- Develop 13 Agri-Cluster Zones as export zones
- Establish an Agri-Export Cell to facilitate agricultural exports in every district
- Establish state-of-the-art perishable cargo centres at the airports of Vadodara, Surat and Rajkot



Scaling Up Agri-Infrastructure

We will invest ₹10,000 crore under Gujarat Krishi Infrastructure Kosh to develop a holistic system of Khedut Mandis, modern APMCs, sorting and grading units, cold chains, warehouses, primary processing centres, etc.

We will promote 2 Agro-Industrial Corridors in Saurashtra to make the agricultural supply chain more cost-effective.

We will establish 5 Mega Agro-Food Parks in Banaskantha, Ahmedabad, Junagadh, Kutch and Vadodara.

We will include land upto 2.5 acres under the Kantari Vad Sahay Yojana for round-the-clock protection of crops.





Building Unparalleled Irrigation Systems

We will invest ₹25,000 crore to expand the existing irrigation network projects such as Sujalam Sufalam, SAUNI, lift irrigation projects, micro irrigation, drip irrigation and other systems across Gujarat. Under this, we will:

Come up with a roadmap for strengthening and expanding the Water Grid for Kutch and North Gujarat regions by building more than 50 dams and 4 major barrages, irrigating more than 5 lakh acres of land

Increase the availability of irrigation water in tribal areas by building more than 70 weir/barrages and more than 5.000 check dams We will work towards building a 30 km long dam under the Kalpasar project in the Gulf of Khambhat, creating the world's largest freshwater reservoir, to provide irrigation and drinking water in Saurashtra.

We will allocate a fund of ₹1,000 crore to expedite Mission Amrit Sarovar and complete 5,000 water recharge projects by 2025.

We will come up with a Gujarat State Water Management Policy 2023 for a holistic and multidimensional approach to water conservation, storage and distribution.

We will develop model irrigation villages in every taluka, which will showcase the best water management practices.





Remodelling Agriculture through Technology

We will aim to attract investments of ₹1,000 crore to develop a smart farming ecosystem based on new technologies like the Internet of Things, which will provide insights into soil quality, water levels, plant diseases, temperature, etc.

We will come up with a comprehensive roadmap to bring farmers and consumers closer by encouraging and incentivising agri-tech entrepreneurs.

We will introduce drones for realtime monitoring of farm produce, spraying pesticides and fertilisers, and assessing crop damage.



Becoming a Leader in Organic Farming

We will create a fund of ₹1,000 crore to incentivise 5 lakh farmers to move towards organic and natural farming under the Prakrutik Kheti Protsahan Yojana.

We will launch India's first Organic and Natural Produce Marketing Federation.

We will create 10 Organic and Natural Farming Clusters in the state to bring scale and efficiency to the existing value chain.

We will ensure that the Gujarat Natural Farming and Organic Agricultural University is promoted as a Centre of Excellence to train Gujarati farmers in global best practices of organic and natural farming.



We will create model organic and natural farming villages in every taluka, which can become role models in organic farming.

We will promote and incentivise new and emerging types of agripractices like hydroponics and aquaponics.

Advancing the Dairy Sector

We will provide 50% subsidised cattle feed for 2 months when a calf is born under Mukhyamantri Pashudhan Sahay Yojana.

We will allocate ₹500 crore to Gauseva and Gauchar Vikas board to provide financial assistance for building new Gaushalas and upgrading existing ones.

We will set up 1,000 additional Mobile Veterinary Units to provide doorstep animal health services across all the villages of Gujarat.

We will roll out Pashu Aadhar Card and build a supporting IT infrastructure for effective and complete monitoring of the health and vaccination status of all livestock animals.

We will ensure every livestock animal in the state is insured and receives regular checkups and vaccination.





We will build India's first Blue Economy Industrial Corridor in Gujarat, which will include:

- 2 Sea Food Parks (Saurashtra and South Gujarat)
- Building robust trunk infrastructure for plug and play setup of processing industries
- Common support facilities for storage, transportation and export (certification laboratories, warehouses, multi-modal transport, etc.)

We will expand fishing-related infrastructure with components such as:

- Construction and upgradation of jetties
- Modernisation of fish markets with state-of-the-art facilities
- Strengthening the cold supply chain by building small cold storages, adding refrigerated vans and subsidising modern iceboxes

We will ensure 100% mechanisation of boats under the Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana.


We will launch 6 more Boat Ambulances to respond to any medical emergency faced by the fishermen.





We will launch the Gujarat Gati Shakti Master Plan for Multi-Modal Connectivity, which will serve as an exemplary model of integrated infrastructural development, making Gujarat the guiding light in Amrit Kaal. It will bring integrated planning and coordinated implementation of critical projects across Roadways, Railways, Airways and Waterways.





Building Corridors of Prosperity

We will develop the first-of-itskind Parikrama Path of 3,000 km encircling the whole state with 4-6 lane roads/highways:

- Part 1: South Eastern Peripheral Highway (India's longest coastal highway, 1,630 km)
- Part 2: North Western Peripheral Highway (1,380 km)



- East-West Corridor: Connecting Dahod with Porbandar(611km)
- North-South Corridor: Connecting Palanpur to Valsad (558 km)

We will connect all district headquarters of Gujarat with the capital city Gandhinagar with 4-6 lane highways to ensure seamless connectivity and faster movement of people and boost intra-state trade.

We will develop a Saurashtra Express Highway Grid to provide seamless connectivity between important economic hubs and national highways.



Advancing Railway Infrastructure

We will facilitate the development of the under-construction Mumbai-Ahmedabad High-Speed Rail Corridor, hosting India's first Bullet Train Project.

We will work with the Central Government to kickstart work on Regional Rapid Transit System (RRTS) to transform the mobility of people within the Ahmedabad-Gandhinagar region (on the lines of Delhi-Ghaziabad-Meerut RRTS).

We will facilitate the completion of the Taranga-Ambaji-Abu Road railway line in record time. We will facilitate the modernisation of all Railway Stations across Gujarat ensuring world-class amenities and ecofriendly infrastructure.

We will make Gujarat a railway crossing-free state by constructing railway over-bridges and under-bridges to ensure safe and convenient travel for commuters across the state.

Building Best Air-Connectivity Network

We will make Gujarat No. 1 in the Civil Aviation sector by operationalising the largest number of international and domestic airports and doubling the volume of passengers by:

Building the new greenfield Dholera International Airport by 2025

- Launching the Rajkot Hirasar International Airport by 2023, which will facilitate the growth of Saurashtra
- Developing airports and heliports in Tier 2 and Tier 3 cities to facilitate the movement of chartered flights, air ambulances and cargo aircrafts
- Developing new terminals and runways at existing airports to double their cargo and passenger handling capacity
- Providing government assistance in adding routes and increasing the frequency of flights in under-serviced airports
- Building Water Aerodromes in tourist destinations such as Ambaji, Palitana and Tapi
- Ensuring seamless movement of passengers and goods, by building connectivity infrastructure at all airports



Amplifying Intra-State Transportation

We will launch the One District One Bus Port programme where one large Bus Depot equipped with world-class amenities and state-of-the-art infrastructure will be developed under the PPP model. We will introduce a fleet of 1,000 E-Buses to connect small towns and villages with the nearby urban centres to ensure last-mile connectivity across Gujarat.

We will ensure 50% of the GSRTC fleet of buses run on LNG and Hydrogen fuel to reduce pollution.

We will modernise all the Bus Depots across Gujarat.





We will facilitate infrastructure creation across major and minor ports to maintain Gujarat's numero uno position as the maritime gateway to India and double the cargo handling capacity of Gujarat's ports.

We will ensure that all the major and minor ports are connected with the nearest highway and upcoming expressway for seamless movement with the rest We will set up 8 world-class Multi-Modal Logistics Parks in Ahmedabad, Vadodara, Surat, Bharuch, Valsad, Rajkot, Kandla and Bhavnagar under the Bharatmala Pariyojana for the seamless movement of goods and services, bringing down logistics cost, and reduce vehicular pollution and congestion.

We will expand the existing network of ferry and Ro-Ro pax across the state by adding new destinations such as Pipavav, Mul Dwarka and Mundra.

Welfare and Development of the Disabled

We will become the first state to achieve all the goals under the Sugamya Bharat Abhiyan by making government offices and public places infrastructurally accessible for PwDs.

We will set up the country's largest National Para Sports Academy with advanced equipment and facilities.

We will set up one Sahyog Centre in every district to provide support and residential care for low-income PwDs who are orphaned, abandoned, or facing destitution.



We will double the financial assistance given to senior citizens under the Niradhar Vruddh Pension Yojana.

We will create a corpus of ₹160 crore and establish separate Geriatric Specialisation Units at every district hospital in the state.







Welfare and Development of the Refugees

We will initiate the Mukhyamantri Sharanarthi Yojana for the welfare of refugees who get citizenship under the Citizenship Amendment Actin Gujarat. Under this, we will:

- Ensure DBT of ₹10,000 per year to each refugee family for 5 years after acquiring citizenship
- Enable a single-window clearance to get documents such as Aadhaar card, Ration card and Voter ID card
- Provide subsidised loans to start their own business
- Provide scholarships to school and college students

Celebrating the Cultural Glory of Gujarat

We will invest ₹2,500 crore to promote Gujarat's culture at the national and international levels.

We will build a circuit of the biggest and first-of-its-kind museums in India:

- Maritime Museum in Lothal
- National Tribal Freedom Fighter Museum in Rajpipla
- Museum of Indian History and Culture in Ahmedabad (India's biggest museum)
- National Museum of Unity at Kevadia



We will set up 4 Umashankar Joshi Centre for Performing Arts in Ahmedabad, Surat, Vadodara, and Rajkot, to promote Gujarati theatre, dance, music, folk art and literature.

We aim to build Sardar Bhawan across India and select international locations to promote Gujarati tradition and culture.

We will increase the funding to the Gujarat Sangeet Natak Academy and Gujarat Lalit Kala Academy for the promotion of various forms of Gujarati art, dance and music.

We will put Gujarat's festivals on the international map by creating a round-the-year festival calendar: Modhera Dance Festival (January), Kite Festival (January), Dang Darbar (March-April), Madhavpur Ghed Fair (April), Saputara Monsoon Festival (July-August), Tarnetar Mela (August-September), Janmashtami Festival (September), Shamlaji Fair (November) and Navratri Festival (November).

We will institutionalise a 3-day long celebration Gujarat Gaurav Mahotsav on Gujarat Foundation Day (1 May).

We will establish a Film City in Ahmedabad with film and television studios, a film training institute, post-production facilities, and other amenities. We will start Ranchhodbhai Dave Gujarati Theater Festival under which we will organise shows of Gujarati plays across domestic and international locations.

We will showcase the diversity and richness of Gujarati cuisine to the world by organising the Gujarati Food Festival across various cities in India and abroad.

We will introduce the Mukhyamantri YUVA scheme, an author mentorship programme under the Gujarati Sahitya Parishad to train young and budding authors in order to promote reading, writing, and book culture in the state.

We will revive the martial art of Vajra Mushti by encouraging akhadas that train people in this combat art form.



Invigorating Spirituality in Gujarat

We will build Devbhumi Dwarka Corridor to establish it as western India's biggest spiritual centre, comprising of:


- World's tallest Shree Krishna statue
- 3D immersive Bhagwat Gita experience zone
- Viewing gallery for the lost city of Dwarka

We will invest ₹1,000 crore to renovate, expand and promote temples, following the successful transformation model of Somnath, Ambaji and Pavagadh. Under this. we will include:

Rudra Mahalaya Mandir in Siddhpur (Patan), Dakor Temple (Kheda), Bechraji Mandir (Mehsana), Mata No Madh Mandir (Lakhpat, Kutch), Sun Temple in Kotai (Kutch), Sapteshvar Mahadev Mandir (Sabarkantha), Meladi Mata Mandir (Viramgam), Nava Surajdeval Temple (Surendranagar), Chandramouleshwara Mahadev Mandir (Dholka), Hanumanji Temple (Anand), Kamnath Mahadev Mandir (Amreli), Chamunda Mata Temple (Chotila), and Shreebai Mataji temple (Junagadh), Sikotar Mata Temple (Jafrabad), Nadinath Mahadev Temple (Mahisagar), Ravechi Mataji Temple (Ravechi).

We will beautify and build additional infrastructure in Tarpan Bhoomi - Chanod, Sidhpur and Prachifor pilgrims.

We will promote Sihor (Bhavnagar) as "Chhota Kashi", with its 9 Nath and Swayambhu Gautameshwartemples.



We will make a Master Plan for Palitana, in line with the development of Ambaji and Dwarka, and develop it as an important location on the Jain tourism map.



Honouring Cultural Heroes

We will begin a series of stage dramas and musicals depicting the journey of Gujarat's famous historical figures and significant events, such as Raja Siddhraj Jaisinh, Veer Hamirji, Gandhiji, Sardar Patel, Vitthalbhai Patel, Ravi Shankar Maharaj, Shivaji Maharaj, Maharaja Sayajirao, and Dandi Satyagraha.

We will build memorials/statues to honour religious gurus, social reformers, historical figures and freedom fighters such as Govind Guru, Sant Sadaram Bapu, Veer Dedaji Barad, Manibhai Desai, etc.

We will expedite the completion of the development of Narsinh Mehta Lake in Junagadh city honouring the Bhakti poet.



Encouraging Artists and Craftspersons

We will felicitate 100 Gujarati artists every year with a cash prize of ₹51,000 under the Gaurav Puraskar Samaroh, for their outstanding achievement in the fields of music, dance, drama, and folk art.

We will establish Craft Haats in each district of Gujarat based on the model of Ahmedabad's Vastrapur Haat for the promotion of handicrafts.

We will develop Craft Village Complexes with Experience Zones, Trade Facilitation Centres and Galleries to build a holistic ecosystem for traditional artisans. Under this, we will set up Craft Villages in:

- Ajrakhpur (Block printing)
- Nirona (Rogan painting)
- Hodka (Traditional craft embroidery)
- Khavda (Clay pottery)
- Dhordo (Chain-stitch work)
- Sumrasar (Soof embroidery)
- Loria (Embroidered footwear)
- Nakhatrana (Bandhani work)
- Padhdhar (Ahir embroidery)
- Anjar (Metal crafts)





Promoting Thematic Tourism

We will promote the heritage of Gujarat under the Gujarat Heritage Tourism Policy 2020-25. Historical monuments, forts, and landmarks associated with the erstwhile princely states will be linked under the Royal Heritage Tourism Circuit to showcase the rich cultural history of Gujarat.

We will promote Beach Tourism by ensuring the beautification of significant beaches in the state, such as Mandavi, Dwarka, Somnath, Tithal, Porbandar, etc. and ensure their certification as Blue Flag beaches like Shivarajpur.

We will promote Food Tourism in Gujarat by organising Food Walks on Sundays across Mahanagar Palikas.

We will launch a Gujarat Medical Tourism Policy and encourage medical value travel.

We will promote Gujarat as a centre of wellness tourism by incentivising setting up Ayurveda Parks, Yoga and Wellness Retreats, and Naturopathy Centres in Jamnagar, Kevadia, and Dharoi.

We will promote MICE tourism by constructing five world-class Lotus Convention Centres in Statue of Unity, Surat, Vadodara, Rajkot, and Kutch, each with state-of-the-art facilities for business travel.

We will identify at least 50 destinations near lakes, rivers and waterfalls and transform them into ecotourism sites.


We will transform Gujarat's hill stations such as Saputara, Wilson Hill, Don, and Girnar into sites of world-class adventure tourism.




