Respected Shri Yogi Adityanath ji,

This letter is in continuation of the telephone conversation I had with your esteemed-self this morning regarding the death of Shri Anurag Tiwari, IAS officer, under mysterious circumstances a few days ago in Lucknow.

In my previous letter dated 17th May, I had requested you to ensure a thorough probe as the tragedy looks murky.

Now I am getting information from credible sources that Shri Tiwari could be a victim of food grain smuggling mafia. This is what middle level officials in Karnataka government are discussing among themselves in a hushed tone.

Let me explain. A multi-crore scam was unearthed in the Department of Food and Civil Supplies some time ago. This was being investigated by Shri Anurag Tiwari in his capacity as Commissioner of the said department. It is being said that he had prepared a detailed dossier about the scandal. This is one important angle which needs to be probed. In fact, Shri Anurag Tiwari's brothers have also expressed their fear of "powerful forces and unseen hands" behind the death of the IAS officer.

Since the entire episode involves two states, Uttar Pradesh - where Shri Tiwari was found dead - and Karnataka - to the cadre he belonged - this matter warrants an investigation by the Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI). The case assumes importance as a new angle of the alleged involvement of the food grain smuggling mafia has come up.

As discussed with you this morning, I request you to kindly refer this Anurag Tiwari death case issue to the CBI. All of us are interested to see that the truth comes out and the mystery is unravelled.

Kindly oblige and do the needful.
